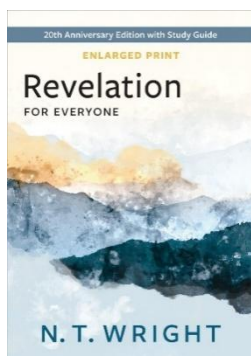

3. FAITH SEEKING UNDERSTANDING THIS LENT – Thursdays @ 4pm

Exploring one of the most awe-inspiring and mystifying books of the Bible, Revelation for Everyone is a book study by N.T. Wright and will be offered on Thursdays, beginning February 19th at 4:00pm. Each week the location alternates between parishes, St. George's Blue Mountains and Christ Church. It begins at Christ Church on February 19th. (Facilitated by Canon Gray and Fr. Brendon).

4. **Tuesday, February 17th**, Shrove Tuesday, aka Pancake Tuesday (Gluten Free available) is held at Knox Presbyterian Church Meaford, 197797 Grey Rd. 7, with all Meaford churches.

The burning of palms will take place there at 4:15pm and the supper runs from 5 to 7pm. Freewill donations welcome – all donations go to the Meaford Foodbank. Live music, free pancakes.

5. Join us for a special service, on Ash Wednesday, February 18th with the *Imposition of Ashes*, an ancient way to begin the season of Lent. The service is at 10:30am – all are welcome.

6. Please bring in your palm crosses from last year to be burned on Shrove Tuesday and used at the Ash Wednesday service. They can be dropped off anytime the church is open, up until February 15th, the Last Sunday in Lent.



7. Repair Cafe – Saturday, February 14, 2026. Be sure to tell friends and neighbours to bring in their small items to get repaired – rather than throwing them in the landfill and enjoy a cup of coffee with us. The cafe runs from 9:00-12:00noon.

8. **Vestry Sunday – is February 22nd**. Please ensure you have this date marked on your calendar. This is your opportunity to have your say in the operation of the church, including voting on the new budget for 2026 - where your attendance and vote is very important to our parish. The brief meeting will follow our regular church service, with coffee/tea/juice & a light lunch provided.

9. Last week, Archbishop Sarah Mullally's election was confirmed at St. Paul's Cathedral London, UK, making her the first woman to officially become Archbishop of Canterbury in the 1400 year history of the office. She will be installed in Canterbury Cathedral in March.
