- 1) The number of undernourished people in the world has been estimated at 690 million people.
- 2) Due to increasing levels of war and conflict, and the weather unpredictability (droughts, floods, season changes) brought on by climate change, the number of hungry in the world has been increasing for the last 5 years.
- 3) COVID-19 is expected to add more than 130 million people to the total of undernourished in the world.
- 4) By the end of the year, 270 million of the world's hungry could be in an acute hunger situation. In other words, they could be facing starvation.

It is more important now than ever that we do all we can to help those in need. Yes, it seems to be a world away, but as the World Food Programme's award of the Nobel Peace Prize shows, peace and food are inextricably linked - without food, there cannot be peace. Developing a peaceful world by feeding others is good for them and it is good for us.

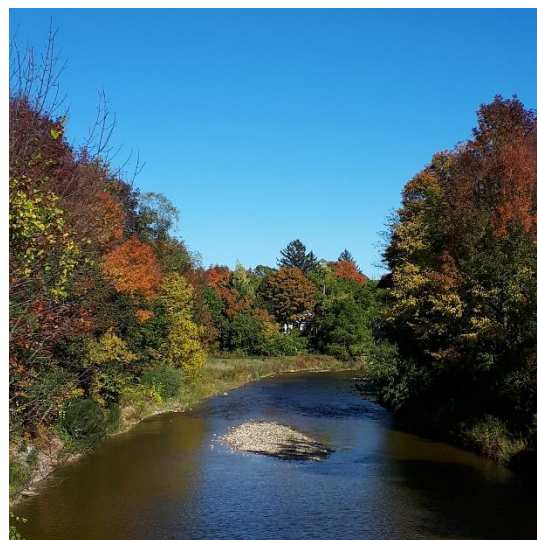
