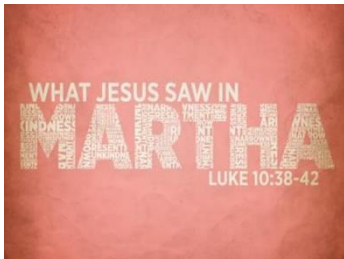




**Christ Church Anglican Meaford

### 2. New Casserole Ministry



**Jesus said, "for I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink." - Matthew 25:35**

Christ Church is starting a new Casserole Ministry. Fr. Brendon and Fr. Gilles are hoping you might consider signing up to be participants in this needed ministry. When you're sick, are in distress, have had a new baby, or something else, making a meal can be an onerous task when combined with everything else. When someone or a family is ill or in need of a meal for another reason, we are looking for a list of those willing to be on-call to make a lasagna, a casserole, a stew, or something like that which would be able to be dropped off by one of our priests to the individual or family in need. Calls would not likely be often, especially if we have a number of volunteers who can be called upon.

### 3. Restarting the Sidesperson Ministry

The ministry of a sidesperson is vital to welcoming those who are attending, visiting, or exploring for the first time the Christ Church community. Welcoming doesn't necessarily mean striking up a long conversation, but rather things like greeting those who arrive with a bulletin, helping them find a seat, answering general questions, or passing along the location of the washroom, among others. By helping to make Sunday morning a welcoming experience for those attending and addressing concerns or questions they might have, you are helping to enable a time of genuine prayer for them.

This would be on a scheduled basis and you would not be required to serve in this ministry every Sunday.
