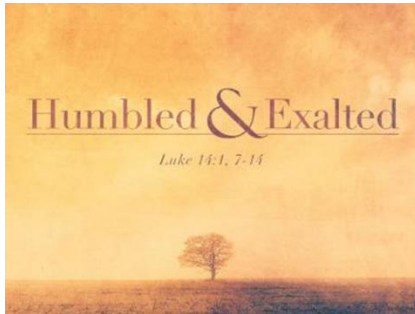

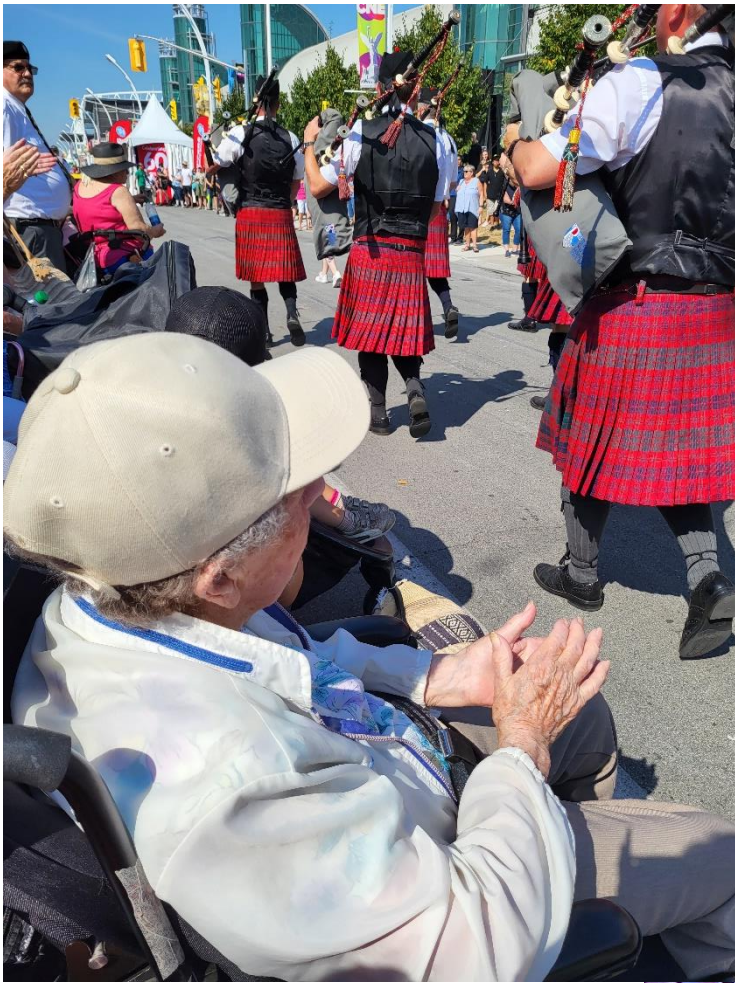


Photo (below) of Evelyn Chipperfield, (Gail Latour's mom) taken from Saturday's late evening news on CTV Toronto.
